



ROOTONE AND URJ COUPON POLICY

Updated as of November 18, 2022

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions (“Terms and Conditions”) set forth the requirements for accepting and applying this certificate or coupon (the “Coupon”) to an Israel trip or program sponsored and organized by the Union for Reform Judaism (the “URJ”).

RootOne LLC is a Delaware limited liability company whose sole member is the Board of Jewish Education, Inc. d/b/a The Jewish Education Project, a New York not-for-profit corporation, (“RootOne,” and together with URJ, “we” or “our”). RootOne’s charitable mission is to help reduce the cost of summer trips to Israel for Jewish high-school age teens by granting funds to qualified grantees.

The Coupon is limited to the named person listed on the Coupon. The Coupon may only be redeemed towards tuition for one of URJ’s Yallah! Israel summer programs (the “Trip”), while space is available on the Trip, and only while our funding lasts. First come, first serve. Only one (1) Coupon per person may be redeemed for one Trip. This Coupon may not be redeemed toward any other URJ youth program or camp. This Coupon may not be redeemed for an Israel program run by an organization other than the URJ. ACCEPTANCE GUIDELINES

1. The Coupon cannot be exchanged for cash. The Coupon does not have any cash value.
2. Coupon must be valid and in date.
3. The Coupon holder must satisfy RootOne’s voucher eligibility requirements at the time the Coupon is redeemed. Eligibility requirements can be found in the FAQs on RootOne’s website [here](#).
4. We do not accept expired Coupons.
5. We have the right to refuse, or limit the use of any Coupon, for any reason.
6. URJ will validate \$250 of the coupon to be applied immediately to coupon holder’s Yallah! Israel account.
7. The Coupon holder must complete RootOne’s voucher application process (found on the RootOne website [here](#)) for the remaining \$3,000 to be applied to coupon holder’s Yallah! Israel account.
8. The Coupon holder must complete and satisfy RootOne’s educational requirements to retain the \$3,000 from RootOne. The educational requirements can be found [here](#).
9. Program participants who are removed from a program for misconduct or failure to follow codes of conduct and policies will be responsible for reimbursing the URJ for the cost of the Coupon.

10. Coupons are not redeemable for cash or for other URJ non-Israel programs, even in the event of a trip cancellation.

EXPIRATION

We do not accept expired Coupons. Coupons are expired upon the Coupon holder's failure to satisfy RootOne's voucher eligibility requirements. Eligibility requirements can be found in the FAQs on RootOne's website [here](#).

VOID

Void if: expired, transferred, sold, purchased, auctioned, reproduced, copied, exchanged to any person, entity or group prior to redemption, or altered from original, or where prohibited or restricted by law. Good only in the USA and Canada.
